- WHEREAS,** Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-8-101, provides that a county government may accept donations of money, intangible personal property, tangible personal property, and real property that are subject to conditional or restrictive terms if the county legislative body accepts them by majority vote; and
- WHEREAS,** the Williamson County General Sessions Court operates a DUI Recovery Court treatment program whose mission is to enhance public safety through the reduction of reoffending DUI offenses; and
- WHEREAS,** the DUI Court Foundation of Williamson County, Inc., formally the Restorative Justice Foundation, is a nonprofit entity which supports the Williamson County General Sessions DUI Recovery Court by securing funds and financial aid for the ongoing operation and possible expansion of the DUI Recovery Court treatment program; and
- WHEREAS,** the DUI Court Foundation of Williamson County, Inc. desires to donate \$25,000.00, conditioned on the funds being used for DUI Recovery Court treatment programs and efforts; and
- WHEREAS,** the DUI Recovery Court also received a donation of \$500.00 from a private corporation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Williamson County Board of Commissioners finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Williamson County to accept the generous private donation and the donation from the DUI Court Foundation of Williamson County, Inc. on behalf of the DUI Recovery Court:

**AMENDMENT TWO
OF GRANT CONTRACT 77833-135**

This Grant Contract Amendment is made and entered by and between the State of Tennessee, Department of Commerce and Insurance, hereinafter referred to as the "State" and Williamson County Government, hereinafter referred to as the "Grantee". It is mutually understood and agreed by and between said, undersigned contracting parties that the subject Grant Contract is hereby amended as follows:

1. Contract Section B. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

B. TERM OF CONTRACT:

This Contract shall be effective for the period beginning on October 2, 2023 ("Effective Date") and ending on March 19, 2028, ("Term"). The State shall have no obligation for goods delivered or services provided by the Contractor prior to the Effective Date.

2. Grant Contract Section C.1. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

C.1. Maximum Liability. In no event shall the maximum liability of the State under this Grant Contract exceed five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) ("Maximum Liability"). The Grant Budget, attached and incorporated as Attachment A is the maximum amount due the Grantee under this Grant Contract. The Grant Budget line-terms include, but are not limited to, all applicable taxes, fees, overhead, and all other direct and indirect costs incurred or to be incurred by the Grantee.

Required Approvals. The State is not bound by this Amendment until it is signed by the contract parties and approved by appropriate officials in accordance with applicable Tennessee laws and regulations (depending upon the specifics of this contract, said officials may include, but are not limited to, the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, the Commissioner of Human Resources, and the Comptroller of the Treasury).

Amendment Effective Date. The revisions set forth herein shall be effective once all required approvals are obtained. All other terms and conditions of this Grant Contract not expressly amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY SHERIFF TO ENTER INTO
A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF TENNESSEE ACTING
THROUGH ITS COMMISSIONER OF TRANSPORTATION**

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-198(f) authorizes the Tennessee Department of Transportation ("TDOT") to permit local law enforcement agencies to install surveillance cameras on State highway right-of-way to aid in criminal investigations or searches for missing or endangered persons; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County applied and received approval of a proposal, to include the need for a license agreement, to install and operate Law Enforcement Automated License Plate Recognition Cameras ("License") to aid in criminal investigations and searches for possible criminal activity as well as locating missing or endangered persons; and

WHEREAS, the License will permit the Sheriff's Office to use Vigilant Automated License Plate Recognition Cameras at specific locations to identify license plates involved in criminal investigations or location of missing or endangered persons; and

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Board of Commissioners finds it in the interest of the citizens of Williamson County to grant the Williamson County Sheriff the authority to enter into a license agreement with the State of Tennessee at no cost to Williamson County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Williamson County Board of Commissioners, meeting in regular session, this the 10th day of March, 2025, hereby authorizes the Williamson County Sheriff to execute a license agreement and all other related documentation to authorize Williamson County to install and operate the Vigilant Automated License Plate Recognition Cameras within State right-of-way;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective upon passage and action by the Williamson County Sheriff.
